Optional donations of \$5.00 per entry are gladly accepted.

By submission of work to the People's Art Show participants agree to the guidelines set forth below:

The exhibition will be a "Public Forum" - artists themselves, not the Art Gallery or University, will be responsible for the content of the works. Entries may not be submitted anonymously. We request that artists exercise common courtesy and refrain from entering intentionally offensive works. Submissions that interfere with the viewing of other entries may not be installed. Submissions that in the sole discretion of the University are considered unsafe or illegal will not be exhibited. **Work previously shown in the CSU Art Gallery will not be exhibited.**

All submissions must remain in the gallery for the duration of the exhibition. **Pick-up dates are Friday, December 10th and Saturday, December 11th from 10AM to 4PM.** Objects left in the gallery after December 11th will become the property of the gallery unless other arrangements have been agreed to in writing.

The Art Gallery is unable to insure artwork. All works submitted will be at the artist's own risk.

The Art Gallery requests a 25% donation for works sold during the exhibition. Please consider this when pricing your work.

All works will be installed as submitted. Unframed items will be installed with push pins or by other appropriate means. Special instructions for installation must be discussed with a staff member at the time of submission. **Placement of work is solely at the discretion of the gallery staff - special requests for placement will not be considered!**

The Art Gallery may photograph and reproduce all submitted items for publicity purposes only. The public may photograph the works for private use only.

Volunteers are needed to help with installation (experience preferred) and the opening reception. Please speak to a staff member if you would like to volunteer.
