Position: College Lecturer

Cleveland State University, Mechanical Engineering Department invites applications for a renewable, one-year College Lecturer position beginning August 20, 2012 and ending May 15, 2013. Position responsibilities include undergraduate teaching, advising and curriculum development. The successful candidate is expected to teach undergraduate courses in the core mechanical engineering disciplines, as well as participate actively in curriculum innovations, including the development of laboratory instructional materials. An earned doctorate is required for appointment. Normal teaching load is up to 16 credit hours (four courses) per semester. Opportunities for summer teaching are available with competitive fringe benefits. The position is annually renewable for five additional years based on satisfactory performance, programmatic needs, and university financial resources. After a comprehensive sixth year review, the appointee will be eligible for two successive three-year appointments and six year appointments thereafter. Hiring is contingent on maintaining existing levels of funding from the State.

**Minimum Qualifications:** The candidate must have a bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering and an earned doctoral degree in a closely related field. He/she must have good communication skills, good skills in computer aided design and analysis tools and hands-on experience in instrumentation and measurements. He/she must have a strong background in key mechanical engineering disciplines such as machine design, controls, vibrations, thermodynamics, heat transfer or fluid mechanics.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Preference will be given to candidates having teaching and/or industrial experience in a Mechanical Engineering capacity and a professional engineer license.

Applicants should send a letter of interest, curriculum vitae, a brief statement of teaching philosophy and three letters of reference (under separate cover) to Recruitment Chair, College Lecturer Position, Mechanical Engineering Department, Cleveland State University, 2121 Euclid Ave. SH 237, Cleveland OH 44115-2214. A lecture session for students and faculty will be required at the time of the interview. Review of applications will begin on January 17, 2011 and continue until the position is filled.
