

## **General Information & Schedule for Chemistry Placement Examination**

Students wanting to enroll in CHM 261, General Chemistry I, will need to fulfill one of the following pre-requisites:

**A minimum ACT score of 25 or SAT score of 550 on the Mathematics portion of those tests**

**OR**

**Successful completion of CHM 251 College Chemistry I (or equivalent) or CHM 161 Preparatory Chemistry with a grade of C or better in either course**

**OR**

**Take and successfully pass a standard American Chemical Society placement examination. Each student will have two chances to pass the exam, with a minimum two week interval required between attempts.**

The General Chemistry I placement exam will be available, at no cost to the student, on a walk-in basis throughout the Spring and Summer semesters
